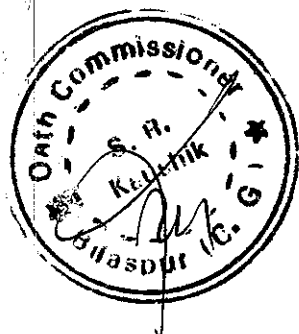

Advocate for the State.</p> <p>Heard on admission.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is working as Sub Engineer E/M, Sub Division Raigarh; he has not made any application to the State Government for transfer and by the impugned order (Annexure P-1) he has been transferred stating that he has made an application for transfer for his own expenses and, therefore, he may be permitted to file representation before respondent No. 1 for redressal of his grievance. To which counsel for the State has no objection.</p> <p>Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of.
