



According to Shri Paranjpe, the petitioner, who is Scheduled Tribe by caste, is holding substantive post of Superintending Engineer, however, the respondent No. 3 has been promoted on the post of Chief Engineer (Civil) against the backlog vacancy of ST category. Challenging above promotion order, the petitioner has also filed representation on 09.01.2014, but the same is not being considered by the respondent authorities.

For this, learned counsel appearing for the State submits that if the petitioner files fresh representation along with copy of this petition, the same shall be considered by the respondent No. 1 in accordance with law.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of. If the petitioner files fresh representation raising all the grounds being raised herein along with copy of this petition, the respondent No. 1 is directed to decide the same on its own merits in accordance with rules as early as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of representation. No order as to costs.
