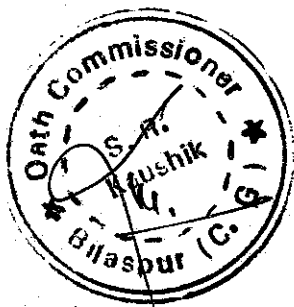

**ORDER (Oral)**

(Passed on 28.5.2014)

1. The petitioner has preferred this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to send him for two years training for appointment to the post of Assistant Veterinary Field Officer.
2. According to the petitioner, he is fully eligible and qualified for being sent on training, however his candidature has been ignored possibly on the ground that he has not passed his matriculation examination with Biology as one of the subject. Learned counsel would further submit that his representation is pending, however, the concerned authority is not deciding the representation and at the same time, training programme is to commence very shortly.
3. Considering the limited nature of dispute as well for the fact that the representation submitted by the petitioner is pending before the Director Veterinary Services, Raipur, therefore, instead of keeping this petition pending, the same is disposed of with a direction to the Director, Veterinary Services, Raipur to consider representation in accordance with law and decide the same by a reasoned order as early as possible preferably within a period of 15 days from today.

4. Needless to say that if the petitioner is fully eligible, qualified and is coming within the zone of consideration, he may be sent for training, however, if he lacks in any qualification or suitability, he may be informed by a written communication.
5. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No order as to costs.
6. Consequently, I.A. No.1 and I.A. No.2 stand disposed off.
