This is first application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. filed
on behalf of applicant for grant of anticipatory bail.

Applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Crime No.215/2014 registered against him at Police Station
Sironj, District Vidisha (M.P.) for commission of offence
punishable under Section 304/34 of IPC.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the
applicant submits that he wants to withdraw the application if
liberty is granted that on surrender if applicant moves an
appropriate application for his regular bail before the trial court
it be decided on the same day.

Accordingly, this Mcrc stands dismissed as withdrawn.
Liberty is granted to applicant that he shall surrender before
the trial court on or before 15th September, 2014 and if he
moves an application for his regular bail in that event learned
trial court/competent court is directed to decide his bail
application as soon as possible, preferably on the same day
after perusal of the case diary/charge-sheet as the case may be,
in accordance with law.
