The petitioner before this court has filed this present petition claiming proper fixation of salary.

The petitioner in the present case who was appointed as Assistant Teacher and his contention is that he has not been granted proper pay scale by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued before this court that the State Government has now issued Circulars dated 12-02-2014 clarifying the position in respect of high pay scale and the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner, keeping in view the circular dated 12-02-2014.

Learned Government Advocate has not objected to the reasonable prayer of the petitioner.

Resultantly, the writ petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to submit a detailed representation to the respondents and the respondents shall decide the representation of the petitioner taking into account the circular dated 12-02-2014, within a period of two months.

In case the petitioner is entitled for grant of benefits as per Circular dated 12/02/2014, the respondents shall also release the monetary benefits to the petitioner, within a period of ninety days, thereafter.

With the aforesaid petition stands disposed of.
