This is first bail application filed by the applicant under section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail.

The accused/applicant was arrested by the Police Station – Dhar District – Dhar in Crime No.164/2014 under sections 363 and 366 of IPC.

According to the prosecution story, two daughters of complainant Jeejabai were kidnapped and the present applicant, it is alleged, tried to sale of the girls for flash trade.

Learned Dy. GA opposes the bail application.

Arguments heard, case diary perused.

After going through the case diary and taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits of the case, I am of the view that it is a fit case for grant of bail. The application filed under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. is

allowed.

It is directed that the applicant – Manjubai W/o Jamnalal shall be released on bail on her furnishing a personal bond of **Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only)** and one local solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Magistrate for her appearance on all the dates of hearing as may be directed in this regard during trial.

She is further directed that on being so released on bail, she would comply with the conditions enumerated under section 437(3) Cr.P.C. meticulously.
