This is first bail application filed by the applicant under section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail.

The accused/applicant was arrested by the Police Station – Afjalpur District – Mandsaur in Crime No.382/2014 under section 34(2) of MP Excise Act for keeping in his possession 72 bulk liters of contraband country liquor.

Learned Dy. GA opposes the bail application on the ground that there are four criminal cases pending against the present applicant. One case was registered against him in the year 2013, which was under section 34(2) of MP Excise Act.

Arguments heard, case diary perused.

After going through the case diary and taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the

case, without commenting on the merits of the case, I am of the view that it is a fit case for grant of bail. The application filed under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. is allowed.

It is directed that the applicant – Satyanarayan S/o Bagdiram Morya shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond of **Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only)** and one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Magistrate for his appearance on all the dates of hearing as may be directed in this regard during trial.

He is further directed that on being so released on bail, he would comply with the conditions enumerated under section 437(3) Cr.P.C. meticulously.
