Heard on **I.A. Nos.5135/2014 & 5165/2014**, applications for permission to compromise.

The applicants namely Naran Lodhi and Dayaram are present in person, who are duly identified by their counsel.

Their presence is marked.

Similarly, the complainant/victim Sarman S/o Malkhan Pal R/o Madhi Jamuniay, Police Station Gorjhamar, Tehsil Deori, District Sagar is present in person, who is duly of his counsel.

His presence is also marked. He has submitted that he entered into the compromise with free consent and he does not want that the applicants be sent to the jail.

The applicants are convicted for the offences punishable under Sections 325/34 of the IPC, which is compoundable with permission of the Court.

Looking to the voluntariness of the complainant and for peaceful relation between the parties, the applications for compromise are hereby accepted.

In the result, the present revision filed by the applicants namely **Naran Lodhi** and **Dayaram** is

hereby allowed in the light of the compromise. The impugned judgments passed by the both the Courts below are hereby set aside. They are acquitted from the charges of the offences punishable under Sections 325/34 of the IPC.

The applicants are on bail. It is directed that their bail bonds shall stand discharged. They would be entitled to get the fine amount back, they have deposited the same before the trial Court.
