Shri Rajmani Mishra learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard on the question of admission and interim relief.

The only prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is for a direction to the respondent Collector, Chhatarpur to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner to reimburse the amount received in auction of the bags of wheat seized from the petitioner's father.

The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent/State submits that the representation of the petitioner shall be considered and decided by the authority concerned expeditiously, in accordance with law.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of with a direction to the effect that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent Collector, Chhatarpur alongwith a copy of the order passed today and a copy of the petition within two weeks from today, the concerned authority shall consider and decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously, in

accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months thereafter.

However, it is made clear that this court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore the authority would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter either accept or reject the representation by passing a reasoned order.

With the aforesaid direction, the petition, filed by the petitioner stands disposed of.
