1 Heard the learned Counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for State. Perused the papers.

2 This is an application under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The applicant is apprehending his arrest at the hands of Crime Branch, Bandra and had therefore, approached the Court of Sessions, Greater Mumbai seeking pre-arrest bail. The Sessions Court was of the opinion that the apprehension is not well

founded and had therefore, rejected the application on 13th October, 2014. Hence, this application.

3 The learned APP has taken instructions and has called for the report from the Crime Branch. Crime Branch has informed that no offence is registered against the applicant till today.
