## **CONCILIATION ORDER**

The learned counsel for the claimant-appellant and the learned counsel for the BMTC along with its representative are present.

2. This is a claimant's appeal for enhancement of compensation as against the Judgment and Award passed by the Tribunal. By mutual consent of the parties, it is agreed for enhancement of global compensation by another sum of Rs.38,000/- (Rupees Thirty eight thousand only), in addition to what has been awarded by the Tribunal, in full and final settlement of the claim. A joint Memo is filed on behalf of the parties to this effect.

3. The Respondent -BMTC has agreed to deposit the said amount before the Tribunal within six weeks from the date of preparation of award, failing which the said amount shall carry interest at the rate of 9% P.A. from the date of default, till the date of deposit.

4. The entire enhanced compensation amount shall be released in favour of the appellant.

5. This miscellaneous first appeal stands disposed of in terms of the Joint memo. The Judgment and Award of the Tribunal shall stand modified accordingly. Draw up the Award accordingly.
