This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Crime No.130/2012 of Narasimharaja Police, Mysore, for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 302 read with 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 and 4 of D.P.Act.

This petition coming on for Orders this day, the court made the following:

ORDER

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader.

2. The present petitioner is said to be accused no.1 and is arraigned as an accused on allegations identical to the allegations made in respect of accused no.4. This Court in Criminal Petition No.786/2014, has granted bail to the said accused no.4, by its order dated 13.5.2014 and hence by parity of reasoning, the present petitioner is also entitled to be released on bail.

Hence, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is enlarged on bail on his executing a self bond in a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with a

solvent surety for a like sum to the satisfaction of the court below. The petitioner shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses in any manner. The petitioner shall attend the court on all dates of hearing. The petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of the court below without prior permission.
