This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying to release the petitioner on bail in Crime No.154/2014 of Kudur Police Station, Magadi Taluk, Ramanagara District for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148, 324, 307, 327, 504, 506 R/W 149 of I.P.C.

This Criminal Petition coming on for orders this day, the court made the following:

ORDER

This petitioner is one of the accused along with other accused who are the petitioners in Criminal Petition No.3029/2014. This Court has granted anticipatory bail to those petitioners. Since the allegations against this petitioner are identical, it is appropriate that on a parity of reasoning, this petitioner also be enlarged on bail, as the petitioner was taken into custody, whereas those petitioners were granted anticipatory bail in the given circumstance that the injuries complained of were all minor in nature, which is the subsequent finding as the certificate was produced only before this Court.

- (i) The petition is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) with one solvent surety for a likesum to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly seek to influence the prosecution witnesses.

- (iv) He shall appear before the Investigation officer as and when required and shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer.
- (v) The petitioner shall attend the Court regularly.
- (vi) In case of violation of any of these conditions, the Court is at liberty to pass suitable orders.
