**O R D E R**

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking to have O.P.No.1707/2013 pending before the Family Court, Thrissur to Family Court, Malappuram to be tried along with two other cases pending before the latter court.

2. The marital relationship between the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner and the respondent ran into rough weather and litigations commenced. Both filed petitions for necessary reliefs. While the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner filed petitions before the Family Court, Malappuram, the respondent filed petition before the Family Court, Thrissur.
