JUDGMENT

The petitioner is aggrieved by the non-consideration of temporary permit application given, in the vacancy of a permit granted to the petitioner itself, which however, had expired for want of a renewal application. The petitioner admittedly has filed a renewal application with delay, which shall be considered in accordance with law.
