ORDER

The petitioner has come up with the above writ petition seeking a direction to the respondent to consider his representation for settlement of dues.

2. Heard Mr.C.Munusamy, learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner claims to be a registered contractor with the respondent Board. He was awarded a contract in the year 2008. After execution of the work order, the respondent ought to have settled the dues to the tune of Rs.8,89,395/- to the petitioner. However, the respondent did not settle the same. Therefore, the petitioner sent a representation dated 22.9.2014 to the respondent. Since it did not evoke any response, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Considering the limited nature of the prayer sought and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 22.9.2014 on

merits and pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
