
ORDER

This petition has been filed to direct the learned III Additional District (PCR) Judge, Madurai to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day on merits in the event of his surrender in connection with Crime No.392 of 2014 on the file of the respondent.

2. The petitioner is alleged to have committed an offence under Sections 294(b), , 427, 324, 323, 506(i) r/w 4 of TMWH Act, U/s.3(1)(x) of SC/ST Act. It is stated by the petitioner that he is an innocent person.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submits that the petitioner is prepared to surrender before the lower Court to co-operate with the prosecution and his petition for bail may be ordered to be considered on the same day.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital.



5. Considering the submission of the petitioner and considering the facts and circumstances by issuing a direction to the lower Court to dispose of the petition for bail on the same day, no prejudice would be caused to the prosecution, the following direction is issued to the lower Court:

"In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the lower Court and his filing of petition seeking bail, the lower Court shall dispose of the said petition for bail on the same day strictly on merits and in accordance with law."

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
