PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police in Cr.No.701 of 2014, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of IPC, have come forward with the present petition seeking for anticipatory bail.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The case of the prosecution is that on 24.09.2014, when the defacto complainant was riding in his Tata Indica Car, the petitioners were riding their two wheelers in rash and negligent manner. The petitioners forced the defacto complainant to stop his car and scolded him with filthy language.

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), the injured has been discharged from the hospital and no weapon has been used.

5. Considering the fact that the origin for the dispute is flimsy and that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, No.I, Madurai District and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs. Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent



Police once in a week i.e. on the first Working day of every week at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C., scrupulously.
