PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as an accused apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 120(B), 420, 448, 465, 468, 471 and 477(A) of IPC, in Crime No.30 of 2013, on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

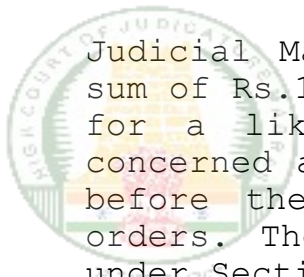
2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons had made destruction and manipulation of the records in the office of the Sub Registrar, Pudukottai.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he is only power agent to the alleged document. He further submitted that the co-accused were enlarged on anticipatory bail in Crl.O.P(MD)Nos.19701 and 19998 of 2014.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the co-accused were granted anticipatory bail by this court, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned



Judicial Magistrate, Pudukottai and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
