PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

There are totally two accused and the petitioner is arrayed as A2 and apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged commission of offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.12 of 2014, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has nothing to do with the alleged commission of offence.

3.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) would submit that the investigation is pending

4.This Court, considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegations, is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate NO.1, Muthukulathur and on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police, daily at 11.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
