PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER: The Court Made the following order:-

The petitioner is arrayed as A1 and apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged commission of offences punishable under sections 147, 294(b), 341, 336, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.686 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

- 2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that on account of previous enmity, there was a wordy altercation and the petitioner side also, a complaint has been lodged in crime No.685 of 2013 and as a counter blast to the said case, the present false complaint has been lodged. It is further submitted that A2 to A6 were already enlarged on bail by the lower Court.
- 3. The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) would submit that it is case of case in counter and the counter case has been registered in Crime No. 685 of 2013 and that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital and that the investigation is pending.
- 4. Taking note of the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and it is a case of case in counter, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.
- 5.Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Palani and on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10.000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police, daily at 11.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
