PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was remanded to the judicial custody by the respondent police on 04.03.2014 for the alleged offence under Section 307 IPC in Crime No.82 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner in order to break the love and he has not committed any offence. He would further submit that considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 24 days, he may be released on bail.

3. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the petitioner requested the daughter of the defacto complainant to love him and when the defacto complainant raised hue and cry, the petitioner took the knife and stabbed her on the chest and the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the State and also perused the materials available on record.



5. Considering the nature of allegation and the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 24 days and the injured has been discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail on the following conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thurayur and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m for a period of eight weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.
