PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

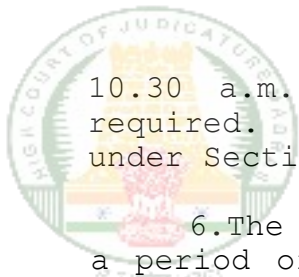
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 406, 409, 468, 420 of I.P.C., in Crime No.246/2014 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case and apprehending arrest, he has come forward with this petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that the petitioner is the staff of the co-operative society from where the alleged goods were purchased.

4.Considering the rival submissions made by both sides and perusal of records, the petitioner has no previous case and even though he was not arrested neither he interfered with the investigation nor he absconded from the jurisdiction of the court, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kodaikanal and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand and only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily at



10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
