ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by A.SELVAM, J.)

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to direct the respondents 1 to 4 to trace out and produce the detenus by name Janaranjani who is said to be the wife of the petitioner and also Logashri, daughter of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is present and he has been identified by his counsel.



3. The fourth respondent viz., Inspector of Police, All Women Police Station, Dindigul has produced the detenus and they have been identified by the petitioner.

Considering the nature of relationship alleged to have been existed in between the petitioner and detenus, this Court is of the view that the relief sought for in the petition has become infructuous and therefore, this petition deserves to be dismissed. If at all the petitioner wants to establish his alleged rights with regard to the detenu by name Logashri, he can work out his remedy through proper forum.

5. In fine, this petition deserves dismissal and accordingly is dismissed on the basis of the observation made earlier.
