ORDER

The Petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the respondent to consider his representation dated 13.11.2013 and pass orders on the same.

2.Mr.S.Kumar, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent and by consent of both parties, the Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage.

3.The grievance of the Petitioner is that he is not paid pension and other retirement benefits, even though he retired as early as on 30.6.2006.

4.According to the Petitioner, he has put in 24 years of service as Secondary Grade Assistant. Therefore he made a representation dated 13.11.2013 seeking for payment of pension. Therefore it is for the respondent to consider the said representation and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law.

5.Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider the said representation and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
