ORDER

The Petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the respondent to consider his representation dated 13.11.2013 and pass orders on the same.

- 2.Mr.S.Kumar, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent and by consent of both parties, the Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage.
- 3. The grievance of the Petitioner is that he is not paid pension and other retirement benefits, even though he retired as early as on 30.6.2006.
- 4.According to the Petitioner, he has put in 24 years of service as Secondary Grade Assistant. Therefore he made a representation dated 13.11.2013 seeking for payment of pension. Therefore it is for the respondent to consider the said representation and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law.
- 5.Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider the said representation and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
