PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

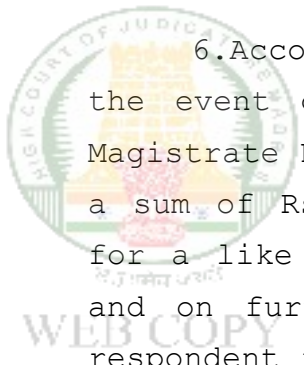
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b) and 307 I.P.C. in Cr.No.505 of 2011 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that when the Advocates were boycotting the Court, on 01.12.2011, the petitioner is said to have represented a case of his relative before the Sessions Court, Ramanathapuram. While so, there was a wordy quarrel arose and the petitioner is said to have assaulted the defacto complainant.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. and a false case has been foisted against the petitioner.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with



6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ramanathapuram District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
