**CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS APPEAL No.2013 of 2004**

**ORDER:** (*Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice L. Narasimha Reddy*)

The marriage between the appellant and the respondent took place on 30.04.1993 and they are blessed with two children. However, in the year 2001, the appellant filed O.P.No.544 of 2001 on the file of the Judge, Family Court, Hyderabad, against the respondent for divorce under Section 13(i)(ia) & (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. After contest by the respondent, the trial Court dismissed the same vide order dated 14.11.2003. Hence, this appeal under Section 19(1) of the Family Courts Act.

We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for the respondent, at length.

As required under the Family Courts Act, we interacted with both the parties on 31.01.2014. ON account of an effort made by this Court, the parties started living together. Today, both the parties appeared before this Court and reported that they are living with utmost harmony. Hence, the cause in the proceedings does not survive.

In view of the above, the appeal is dismissed as

infructuous. The miscellaneous petitions, if any, filed in this appeal shall also stand dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
