The Court made the following:

COMMON ORDER:

These three transfer civil miscellaneous petitions arise between the same parties.

For convenience, the petitioner in Transfer C.M.P.No.420 of 2014 is referred as the petitioner.

The petitioner is the wife of the respondent. As matrimonial disputes arose between the parties, the petitioner filed F.C.O.P.No.24 of 2013 for maintenance and F.C.O.P.No.1588 of 2012 for recovery of certain money. Both the O.Ps. were filed in the Court of Family Judge, Visakhapatnam. The respondent filed F.C.O.P.No.1045 of 2012 in the Court of Family Judge, Ranga Reddy District, for divorce.

The petitioner has filed Transfer C.M.P.No.420 of 2014 seeking to withdraw F.C.O.P.No.1045 of 2012 from the Court of Family Judge, Ranga Reddy District, and transfer the same to the Court of Family Judge, Visakhapatnam, to be tried along with F.C.O.P.Nos.1588 of 2012 and 24 of 2013. Similarly, the respondent has filed Transfer C.M.P.Nos.230 and 231 of 2014 for withdrawing F.C.O.P.Nos.24 of 2013 and 1588 of 2012 from the Court of Family Judge, Visakhapatnam, to be transferred and tried along with F.C.O.P.No.1045 of 2012 by the Court of the Family Judge, Ranga Reddy District.

After hearing the learned counsel for both parties, this Court is of the opinion that it would be in the interests of justice that all the three

cases are transferred to the Court of Family Judge, Vijayawada, which is a center point between Visakhapatnam and Ranga Reddy District.

Accordingly, all the above-mentioned three F.C.O.Ps. are transferred to the Court of Family Judge, Vijayawada, for being tried and disposed of together.

The transfer civil miscellaneous petitions accordingly stand disposed of.

As a sequel to disposal of the transfer civil miscellaneous petitions, interim orders dated 16.04.2014 and 18.07.2014 are vacated and Tr.C.M.P.M.P.Nos.309, 310 and 550 of 2014 shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
