

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY**

**WRIT PETITION No.21658 OF 2014**

**O R D E R :**

The writ petition is filed for a *Mandamus* declaring the action of the respondents in not allotting stocks to the petitioner's fair price shop No.1415 of Lankojanapalli Village, Darsi Mandal, Venkatapuram, Prakasam District, as illegal and arbitrary and for a consequential direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner to continue as fair price shop dealer.

The case of the petitioner is that she was appointed as fair price shop dealer for Shop No. 1415 of Lankojanapalli Village, Darsi Mandal, Venkatapuram, Prakasam District and distributing the essential commodities to the cardholders without any complaint. While so, though the petitioner is having valid and subsisting fair price shop authorisation, the respondents are not supplying stocks to her fair price shop. Aggrieved by the same, she filed the present writ petition.

Heard both sides.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, there shall be a direction to the respondents to supply the essential commodities to the petitioner's fair price shop as long as her authorisation is valid and subsisting or till permanent appointment is made by the respondents whichever is earlier. However, this order will not preclude the competent authority, from taking action against the petitioner, in case if the petitioner commits any violations. It is also open for the competent authority to make permanent appointment.

With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. As a sequel thereto,

miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in the writ petition, shall stand closed.
