After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would raise all the pleas, as have been raised in this petition, before the lower court at the appropriate time and the petitioner would be satisfied if the lower court is directed to decide the suit within a stipulated time.

In view of the above position and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the lower court to decide the suit expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, it is made clear that the observations made in the impugned order (Annexures P-3) would not stand in the way of the petitioner at the time of adjudication of the suit by the lower court.
