State Crime Branch, Haryana, Madhuban has been filed by the State.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Inspector
Ramesh Chand submits that now case is being handled by Crime Branch but
in FIR No. 941 dated 29.07.2011 for offence under Section 365 of the
Indian Penal Code, whereabouts of the husband of the petitioner has still not
been traced.

It is directed that Special Investigating Team be constituted and
the same should be headed by Inspector General of State Crime Branch with
a Superintendent of Police Crime Branch as a member. It is further directed
that SIT so constituted shall complete investigation expeditiously and
preferably within a period of four months.
