## K. KANNAN J.

1. The appeal is for enhancement of compensation for death of a female aged 45 years in a motor accident that took place on 21.08.2000. Both the claimants, who are sons of the deceased, stated that their mother was working as labourer in a factory and was earning ₹ 2500/- per month. The Tribunal while assessing a compensation of ₹ 1,80,000/- took the income of the deceased as ₹ 1500/- per month and adopted a multiplier of 15. I will retain the income assessed by the Tribunal but provide a future prospect of increase at 30% and rework the compensation as under:-

- 2. The total compensation payable shall be ₹ 2,80,900/-. The amount in excess over what has already been provided by the Tribunal shall also attract interest @7.5% from the date of petition till the date of payment. The entitlement shall be distributed equally amongst the claimants. The liability shall be in the same manner as determined by the Tribunal.
- 3. The award stands modified and the appeal is allowed to the above extent.
