Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for

issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the

petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They

are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on

record a copy of matriculation examination certificate (Annexure P-2) wherein her date

of birth is mentioned as 17.11.1996 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a

copy of matriculation examination certificate (Annexure P-3) depicting his date of birth

as 23.03.1988.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Kapurthala, to protect lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent

Nos. 4 to 6.

This order has nothing to do with regard to validity or invalidity of the

marriage of the petitioners.
