The learned counsel contends that petitioner is employed in abroad on contract basis and is not being given break by the employer. In this petition, on 18.02.2014, the arrest of the petitioner, on the basis of warrant of arrest was stayed with a direction to the petitioner to join the enquiry/investigation before the police. Till date, the petitioner has not complied with the order of this Court. Even today, the learned counsel contends that the petitioner is employed abroad and may come to India after 15.12.2014. He seeks long adjournment, which request is declined. The petitioner has no intention to comply with the order. On one side, he is approaching this Court to seek discretionary relief, but on the other

hand, he did not make any effort to come to India to comply with the order of this Court. The petitioner has wasted the precious public time of this Court. So, the petitioner is not entitled to any discretionary relief.

He seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with costs of Rs.15,000/-, to be deposited with the Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, SBS Nagar (Nawanshehar), within three months, failing which it will be recovered as land revenue.
