Petitioners have approached this Court, praying for regularization of their services with effect from the date their juniors have been regularized.

Claim of the petitioners is stated to be covered in their favour by the judgement passed by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.5710 of 2011 (Pawan Kumar and another Vs. State of Haryana and others), decided on 19.07.2012 (Annexure P-5). Petitioners, on the basis of said judgement, have served a legal notice dated 23.02.2014 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents but no decision thereon till date has been conveyed to them.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana, Public
