Challenge in the present writ petition is to an order

passed by Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench,

Chandigarh dated 14.7.2014, whereby an original application filed

by the petitioners was disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioners are the contractual employees working

with the respondents. The grievance of the petitioners before the

Tribunal in the original application was that the advertisement

inviting applications for appointment of contractual employees be

quashed and that the respondents be restrained from terminating

their services, after completion of their contract which is coming to

an end on 15.7.2014.

In reply, the stand of the respondents was that after

15.7.2014, new contract will be executed with the applicants. It is

admitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that in fact the contract has

been executed on 22.7.2014 but some of the petitioners have not been

posted at the same station on which they were working earlier under the old

contract. It is argued that the options were sought from the petitioners but

such options have not been taken note of while executing the new contract.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and find no

merit in the present petition. The options given by the petitioners to be

posted at a particular place do not give any right to the petitioners to be

posted on that place. The posting of a contractual employee is at the

discretion of the employer keeping in view the administrative exigencies.

The grievance of the petitioners was that the contract will not

be executed. The same has been duly executed.

In view of the said fact, we do not find any merit in the present

petition.

Dismissed.
