Having heard the learned counsel of the petitioners it appears that the agricultural land in question has been purchased by the petitioners. They have got their names mutated in the revenue records. Learned counsel of the petitioners argued that the civil court has passed the order restraining the defendants from interfering with peaceful possession of the petitioner over the land in question. This Court is unable to understand whether who is in actual peaceful possession of the land in dispute irrespective of the name of the petitioners in the khasra In any case the petitioners and khatauni. cannot be permitted to take the forceful possession (if they are not in) over the land in question. The contents of the First Information Report shows that they are mighty persons having a muscle strength. Learned counsel for the petitioners also argued that Lachi Ram, who is 80 years old person so in the above circumstances, the court stays the arrest of Lachi Ram. So far as the other petitioners are concerned, they are directed to surrender in the court concerned. Their bail application (s) will be heard at the earliest, if possible on the same day. The writ petition is finally disposed of.

Urgency Application No. 523 of 2014 as well as Stay Application No. 624 of 2014 stand disposed of.
