The only grievance of the petitioner is that application of the petitioner seeking permission for the route known as Parade Ground to Selaqui is not being taken up for consideration in a meeting of RTA for no sufficient reason.

Mr. S.S. Chauhan, learned Deputy Advocate General fairly submits that if application of the petitioner is found to be in order, same shall be considered at its own merit in accordance with law in the next RTA meeting. However, if any formal defect is observed in the application, petitioner shall be given opportunity to cure the defect so that application may be taken up for consideration either in the next meeting or in the next to next meeting positively.

Mr. V.P. Bahuguna, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition may be disposed of in the light of statement made by Mr. S.S. Chauhan, learned Deputy Advocate General.

Ordered accordingly.

CLMA No. 9588 of 2014 also stands disposed of accordingly.
