The counter affidavit filed by the State in the Court is taken on record.

Heard Mr. Gaurav Singh, learned counsel for the applicant, Mr. B.M. Pingal, learned Brief Holder for the State and perused the record.

The applicant before this Court is an accused in Case Crime No. 65 of 2014, which has been registered under Section 302 of I.P.C., P.S. Jwalapur, District Haridwar.

Considering the nature of charges and the fact that as per the prosecution there are four witnesses to the incident, no interference is presently made out. According to the counsel for the applicant, however, in the trial, four witnesses have turned hostile.

Be that as it may, no interference is called for by this Court. Accordingly, the bail application is rejected with the direction that the trial shall be completed
