Instant application has been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of F.I.R. bearing No.68/2014, registered at Police Station, Shastri Nagar, Jaipur [North] for offences punishable under Sections 147, 452, 327, 504, 427 and 323/34 I.P.C.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been enlarged on bail, therefore, the present petitioner may also be released on bail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the view that no case for grant of pre-arrest bail is made out.

At this stage, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the Court below and apply for regular bail.

Considering the alternative submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders himself before the Court below within a period of ten days from today, his application for regular bail shall be decided within a period of three-days, after the period of Police remand is over, considering the fact that co-accused of the petitioner have already been released on regular bail.

In view of above, the present petition stands disposed of.
