By the Court:

*By this writ petition, following prayers have been made which are quoted hereunder:*

*"(a) By an appropriate writ order or direction in nature thereof thereby respondents may kindly be directed to investigate the aforesaid matter fairly, properly and impartially and appoint other higher officer to investigate the matter.*

*(b) Cost of litigation may also be awarded in favour of the petitioner.*

*(c) Any other writ order or direction which may be deemed proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be issued in favour of the petitioner."*

*The perusal of prayer made in the writ petition shows prayer for fair and proper investigation to the FIR lodged against the petitioner. The grounds in the writ petition does not disclose any basis for prayer, rather grounds of the writ petitions are in regard to disconnection of electricity in violation of principles of natural justice, thus grounds are different than the prayer made in the writ petition.*

*It is a case where FIR has been lodged against the petitioner and others for an offence under Sections 332, 353, 186, 189, 342 & 379 of IPC. Few accused were arrested but they were granted bail. The FIR was lodged regarding theft of electricity.*

*The prayer of the writ petition is not supported by the grounds, in any case, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the Investigating Authority to conduct the investigation properly and fairly and without bias.*

*With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition stands disposed of so as the stay application.*
