Contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that even though the petitioners applied for appointment on the post of Pharmacist and they were selected, but so far their appointment orders have not been issued by the respondent.

Having regard to the facts aforesaid, the petitioners are required to approach the respondent by way of filing representation. Upon filing such representation, the respondent shall consider the grievance of the petitioners as to why the appointment orders have not been issued and consider the case of the petitioners for appointment or otherwise decide their representation by giving reasons for not issuing the appointment orders within a period of two months from the date of approaching of the petitioners along with copy of this order.

With the aforesaid direction, writ petition is disposed of.

Stay application also stands disposed of.
