BY THE COURT:-

Contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that respondents have by mistake not given marks of RTET while preparing the final merit of the petitioner as per criteria laid down by the respondents. They were required to add 20% weightage of marks of RTET. It is contended that petitioner is a OBC (physically handicapped) category candidate and the cut off marks is 123 and marks of the petitioner is 117.27 and if the marks of RTET are added petitioner would secure 62% marks i.e. 12.02 more marks would be added totaling to 129.29 marks thus qualifying for selection and appointment on the post of Teacher Grade-III.

This writ petition is disposed of directing respondents to consider the grievance of the petitioner and if the facts aforesaid are found to be correct, redress grievance of the petitioner or otherwise, decide the representation of the petitioner by a speaking order under intimation to him within a period of six weeks from the date of its making.

With that direction, writ petition is disposed of.
