
Heard both sides.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
make correction in the prayer portion of the petition.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioner is the husband and it is submitted on
behalf of the petitioner that he is always ready to keep his wife.
The petitioner is Sub Inspector in Border Security Force and he
never demanded any dowry.

Considering the willingness of the petitioner to keep



his wife, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks from today and the court below shall, after issuing notice to the complainant, grant provisional bail to the petitioner for six months on furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patna in Complaint Case No. 26824 (C) of 2014.

The court below shall make all efforts for reconciliation of the dispute between the husband and the wife. If the dispute is resolved amicably between the parties, the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed. In case the dispute is not resolved, the court below shall pass orders on the prayer for provisional bail of the petitioner on its own merit in accordance with law.
