Petitioner is languishing in custody since 13.07.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act and Section 9(B) of the Explosive Substances Act.

From the Kapila Pashu Ahar Centre 71 filled gas cylinders, 17 empty Indane gas cylinders and 16 filled Bharat gas cylinders were recovered. The Kapila Pashu Ahar Centre was found registered in the name of Sanjeev Kumar Jha though he claimed that the area from which the seizure was made was taken on rent by the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is nothing on record to suggest that the premises in question was let out in favour of the petitioner.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the

petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 111 of 2013, G.R. No. 3290 of 2013.
