The petitioners seek revision of the judgment of conviction dated 21.09.2013 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge 4, Darbhnga in Cr. Appeal No. 22 of 2010 arising out of T.R. No. 1833 of 2009/G.R No. 1861 of 2005.

It has been submitted that since the occurrence had taken place way back in the year 2015 it would be against the interest of justice to put them behind the bars.

Considering this aspect of the matter, the revision

application is dismissed on merit. However, the sentence is modified to the extent that the petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs. 1000/- each as compensation to the informant/his heirs within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of this order. The informant will be at liberty to withdraw the amount on due verification of his credentials.
