Heard Mr. M. Ali, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. K. Munir, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, Assam, appearing for the State respondent.

By this second bail application, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner s namely Afzalur Rahman @ Afzal Hossen, Md. Asraful Bhuyan @ Asraful Islam Bhuyan, Majeda Khatun, Hashmat Ali Bhuyan and Sk Jahangir Alom have prayed for pre-ar rest bail in connection with lakhipur P.S. Case No. 244/2014 under Sections 177/148/149/325/354/379 IPC.

The earlier prayer for bail was rejected by this court vide order dated 24.9.201 4, passed in AB No. 3804/2014, after perusing the case dairy.

The matter relates to assaulting the informant's brother and snatching away gold ring etc. from the possession of the sister-in-law of the informant.

Having heard the learned counsel for both the parties and considering the entire aspect of the matter, I find no new facts and circumstances, requiring granting of pre-arrest bail. Hence, the prayer for pre-arrest bail is rejected. Bail application is dismissed.
