AB 1725/2015 BEFORE HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE C.R.SARMA

Heard Mr. R. Islam, learned Counsel, appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. B B Gogoi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam.

This is the 2nd application, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., se eking pre-arrest bail, in favour of the petitioner, namely, Md. Sofikul Islam, in connection with Chhaygaon P.S. Case No. 334/2014, under Sections 326/498(A)/506/34 IPC.

The earlier prayer for bail has been rejected after perusing the case diary.

The allegation made against the petitioner is that the petitioner subjected the informant to torture in connection with demand of dowry.

Having heard the learned Counsel, appearing for both the parties and considering entire aspect of the matter, I find no new facts and circumstances requiring reconsideration of the earlier order. Hence, the prayer for pre-arrest bail stands rejected.

Bail application is dismissed.
