After hearing Mr. BD Das, the learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. T. Nath, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. JC Chutia, the learned standing counsel, KAAC, representing the respondents, I am of the view that this writ petition need not be kept pending and the same is disposed of today at the motion stage for consideration by the respondent authorities.

The case of the petitioner is that he has been serving as Assistant Teacher in Jamaguri LP School under Howraghat Block of Karbi Anglong district since 2005 and is presently holding the charge of Headmaster of the school apart from his normal duties. There are six classes in the school from pre-primary to Class-V and there are 69 students and two Assistant Teachers including the petitioner in the said school. While serving there, the respondent No.3 by the order dated 4.7.2015 transferred him to Taseng LP School under Socheng Block which is located about 200 KM away. The contention of the petitioner is that his transfer is not issued in public interest and the same is issued in deliberate disregard to the numbers of teachers and students imparting education in the school. Aggrieved by this, the petitioner has filed his representation before the respondent authorities on 22.7.2015 (Annexure-4 to the writ petition) for cancellation of his transfer order. Perused the contents of the representation dated 22.7.2015, which is self explanatory.

The respondent No.1 (Principal Secretary, KAAC, Diphu) is, therefore, directed to examine the representation dated 22.7.2015 submitted by the petitioner and take a decision thereon in accordance with law within a period of 3(three) weeks from the date of receipt of this order. Till such a decision is taken by the respondent No.1, the present posting of the petitioner shall not be disturbed.

The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
